

Operator's COVID-19 Guidelines

Western Midstream Partners formally Anadarko – As of June 26, 2020

1. Requires employees to fill out COVID-19 questionnaire when checking in to shore base or Heliport.
2. Requires employee's body temperature to be taken when checking in to shore base or Heliport.
3. Requires contractors to monitor minimum 14 day quarantine of employees in accordance with section 3.2 of the COVID-19 Management Strategies for Offshore Energy Operations before going offshore.
4. Requires employees to avoid public events, meetings, and gatherings while on shore.
5. Requires employees to practice Enhanced Social Distancing - at all times when outside of their home; to include maintaining 6 feet of distance from others and wearing a face covering.

Arena Offshore – As of June 29, 2020

1. Requires employees to fill out COVID-19 questionnaire when checking in to shore base or Heliport.
2. Requires employee's body temperature to be taken when checking in to shore base or Heliport.

Cantium – AS of July 21, 2020

1. Requires employees to fill out COVID-19 questionnaire prior to checking in to shore base or Heliport.
2. Requires employee's body temperature to be taken when checking in to shore base or Heliport.

COX Operating – AS of July 21, 2020

1. Requires employees to fill out COVID-19 questionnaire when checking in to shore base or Heliport.
2. Requires employee's body temperature to be taken when checking in to shore base or Heliport.

EnVen – As of July 9, 2020

1. Employees are required to report to EnVen's hotel observation camp at the Clarion Inn in Morgan City, LA. 2 to 3 days before they are due to go offshore (employees will be paid straight time by EnVen).
2. Company employee are not to rideshare or car pool with others when traveling to EnVen's hotel observation camp.
3. Upon arrival at the hotel observation camp the employee will fill out a screening questionnaire and have their body temperature taken.
4. A COVID PCR test will be taken and employees will be housed until results are obtained.
5. Employees are required to obtain a negative test result before they can travel to any shore base or heliport.
6. Employees who test positive must follow Linear Controls medical protocol for confirmed COVID-19 case.

Fieldwood – As of March 22, 2020

1. Requires employees to fill out COVID-19 questionnaire when checking in to shore base or Heliport.
2. Requires employee's body temperature to be taken when checking in to shore base or Heliport.

HESS – As of September 11, 2020

1. Requires employees to answer questionnaire prior to going to a HESS shore base or Heliport.
2. Requires employees to self-quarantine for 14 days if ANY recent travel outside the United States.
3. Requires an enhanced health screening at Heliport with an updated questionnaire when checking in to shore base or Heliport.
4. If an employee answers Yes, to any of the questions they will not be allowed to fly and must notify company supervisor.
5. Requires employee's body temperature to be taken when checking in to shore base or Heliport.
6. Requires at-home COVID-19 testing OR have taken a certified PCR test within 7-9 days prior to flight.

LLOG – As of July 22, 2020

1. Requires employees to fill out COVID-19 questionnaire when checking in to shore base or Heliport.
2. Requires employee's body temperature to be taken when checking in to shore base or Heliport.
3. Employees are required to have face mask when reporting to the shore base or Heliport and while in the helicopter.

Murphy Oil – As of May 13, 2020

1. Requires employees to fill out COVID-19 questionnaire prior to going to heliport or shore base and bring it with them for check in.
2. Required to take employee body temperature prior to going offshore.
3. Requires employee to practice social distancing at all times.

W&T – As of July 21, 2020

1. Requires employees to fill out COVID-19 questionnaire when checking in to shore base or Heliport.
2. Requires employee's body temperature to be taken when checking in to shore base or Heliport.
